



The Little Hut is an alternative education and wellbeing centre, based just outside of Saffron Walden, Essex

I offer 1:1 sessions working alongside the dogs and horses, to focus on working towards each individuals goals and aims, whether that be building confidence, working on leaving the house, becoming more active, or learning new skills

Sessions are tailored to each individual, and go at their own pace, incorporating learner-led, animal-led and facilitator directed activities to create a dynamic and positive environment

As an EAQ approved centre, I can also offer nationally recognised qualifications through OCN for those looking for a more structured Alternative Education Provision/EOTAS provision





WELLBEING Sessions



SUITABLE FOR LEARNERS & YEARS AND ABOVE

Wellbeing Sessions work around whatever aspect of the individuals well being or mental health that they have identified as something they want to develop; confidence, social anxiety, mental wellbeing

These sessions are usually horse-led (or dog-led depending on your preference!), spending time interacting with them, unwinding, and creating a safe space where you can take time for yourself

These sessions are useful for those that are looking for a relaxed, non-judgemental space, to take their time in, and create positive experiences

They also work well as a starting point to develop in to alternative education sessions, to get to know myself, the centre and animals, and create a positive relationship towards an educational setting when previous experiences may not have been so good Sensory activities (swings, hammock)

Trips in to the community

Arts and crafts

Walking the horses

Making hay nets and feeds for horses

Any other activities that an individual shows interest in! Grooming the horses

Wellbeing sessions include activities such as...

Mucking out the

horses/poo-picking

Dog walking

Gardening activities

Cooking on the fire pit

Ground work with the horses in the arena

INTERNAL QUALIFICATIONS

There are also a wide variety of small certificates which can be completed during wellbeing sessions, but are much less formal than the OCN units, and will earn a certificate from myself. These are particularly good for learners who have lost their confidence in an educational environment, but still want the challenge of learning new skills and having something to show for it

These include certificates such as;

EDUCATION Sessions



SUITABLE FOR LEARNERS 12 YEARS AND ABOVE

Education sessions are focussed on working towards an OCN Qualification, through the EAQ network.

Qualifications can be completed in various ways; by each unit, by awards, or by certificates. You can also start with a unit and build up from there.

Here are some examples of the type of qualifications offered;

Developing Confidence Working With Animals (1 unit, recommended 27 Guided Learning Hours)

Skills for Professions in Animal Care Award (3 units, recommended 81 GLH)

- Developing Confidence Working With Animals
- Grooming and Washing Horses
- Study Skills

Skills for Professions in Animal Care Certificate (11 units, recommended 285 GLH)

Education sessions focus on completing the work at the learners' own pace, while maintaining a positive and welcoming educational environment.

Sessions are often broken up with the same activities involved in a wellbeing session, to keep students engaged and learning through a variety of approaches

Units are completed through a blend of practical sessions, to build a photographic portfolio of the work completed, and written work tailored to the learners' strengths e.g. Q&A with me scribing, or creating a poster instead of writing a paragraph

The GLH are only a guide, and units might be completed faster or slower than this
